THE KINGDOM OF GOD Matthew 13:31-32 (June)

The original plan of God was that the world we live in today should be the kingdom of man.

**So, God created man in His own image; in the image of God, He created him; male and female He created them. Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."**

**Genesis 1:27-28**


